

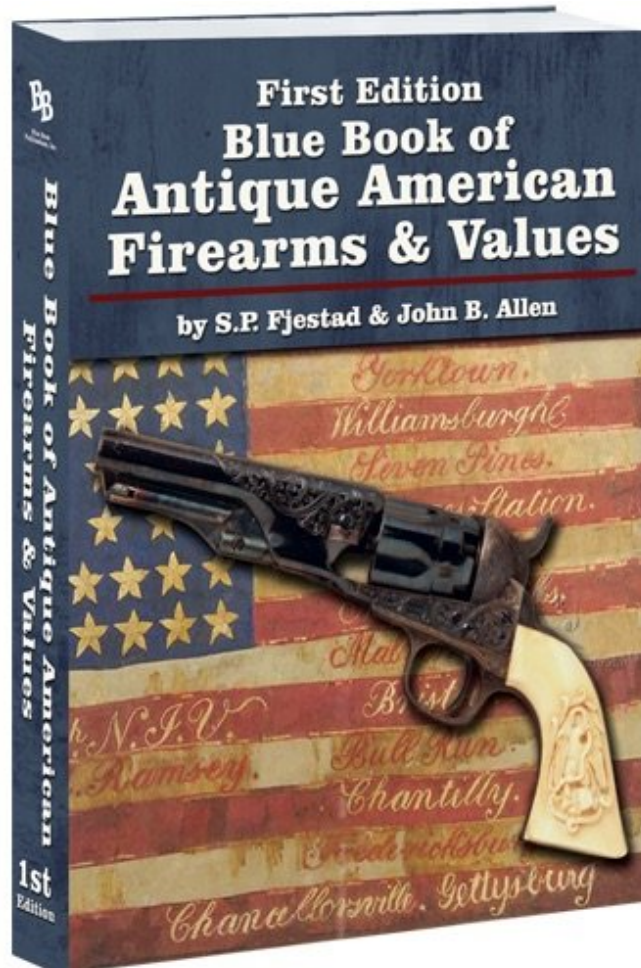

This book comes in second place for me. I had issues with some of the prices listed for some guns, which I thought were too high or too low. There were some variations of guns that wee not listed and omitted. The book is set up alphabetically by manufacturer. There is many guns reviewed in this book and I would still highly recommend you purchase it if you are interested in antique American guns.
