

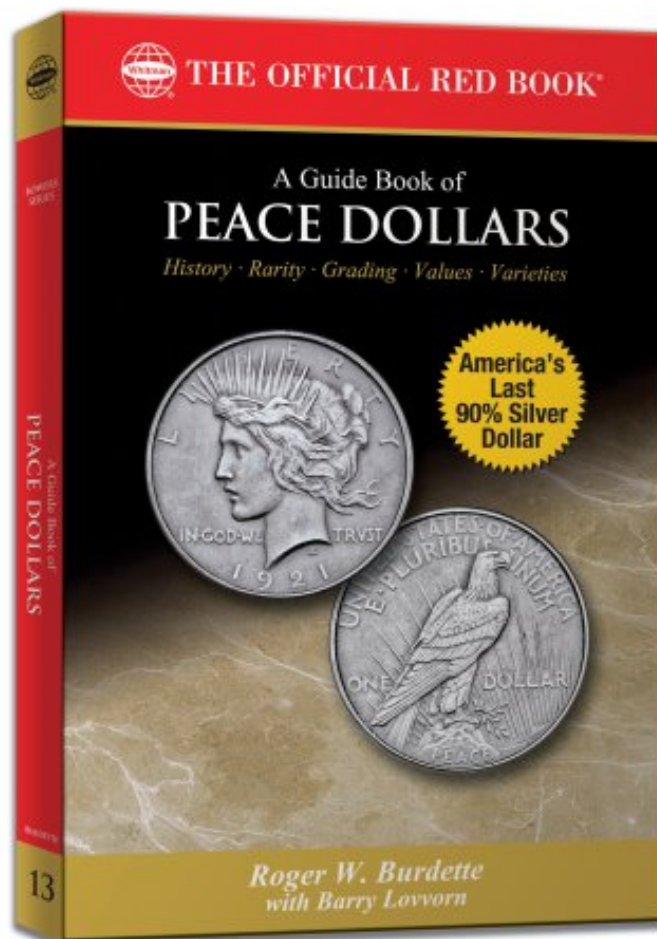

Burdette examines several theories of how 1964-D Peace Dollars could have escaped into circulation, such as substitution of older coins for new ones. The book includes information on errors, proofs, patterns, counterstrikes, and hoards, with many color pictures. I recommend it for anyone who wants to learn more about them. The book is almost evenly divided between history and collecting advice and information. Each date and

mintmark gets its own treatment, with discussion of the strike quality, with pictures, major varieties, mintage figures and certified populations, and more importantly, relative rarity within the set.
