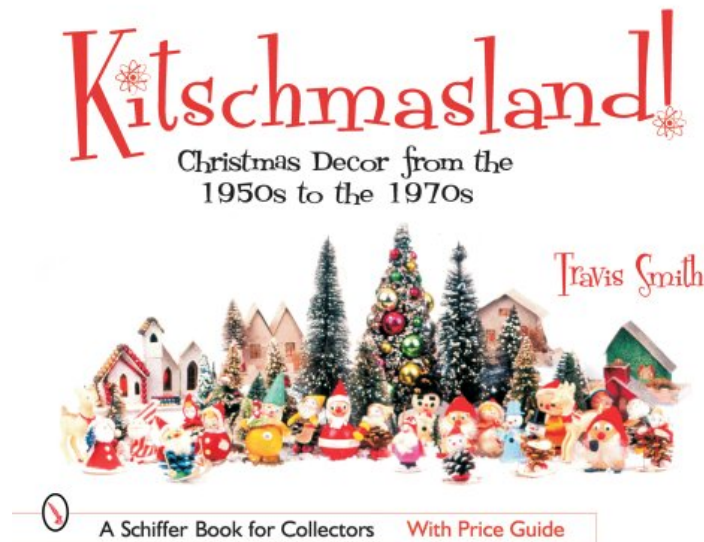

I'm glad to report, while there is an element of "price guide" within the photographs and descriptions, "Kitschmasland!" is a beautiful book to enjoy in its own right, whether you're a buyer/seller of decorative Christmas items or just someone who enjoys nostalgia and holiday memories like me. The color photographs are generally much larger than an inch (most take up an appreciable section of the whole page) and are crisply reproduced. There are many lovely set pieces of decorated rooms, and enough close-ups of ornaments and other particular items to satisfy anyone looking to revel in specific memories of Christmas past. I mean no disrespect to the aforementioned reviewer, but I found this collectors book to be much better than a spare price guide.
