

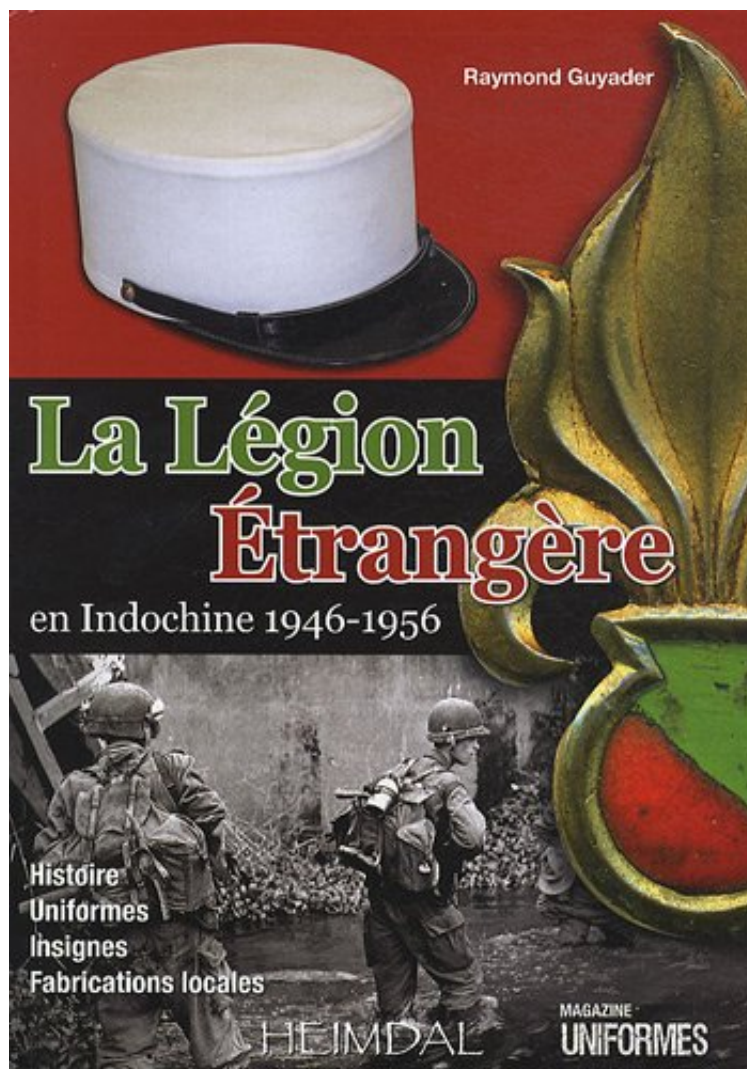

There is very little available on this war in the English language; so, if you want to see photographs and uniform pictures, you have to buy the book in French. This is the only reason I gave this book 4.5 stars and not 5.This book is an awesome overview of the progression of the Legion from the end of World War Two until the beginning of the Algerian War in 1954. It says it goes through 1956, but I couldn't really tell where

it left off for sure. The photos are all first-rate and amazing; they are also very interesting in the fact that most are exclusive to this book. I have only had an interest in this war for about two months, but this book, along with the French Para's in Indochina are very cool helpers in realizing the plight of the logistical problems during this war. I actually got this book for my dad for father's day, but I snaked it and enjoy it thoroughly myself. I am waiting for the book on the French Para's in Algeria to come down a little in price; that book looks just as cool as this one, for sure. I love anything with pictures and actual uniform poses, and these two books deliver big time. Outstanding reference By Robert A., Shoaf Another excellent volume by Heimdal. This book offers comprehensive coverage of Foreign Legion uniforms and equipment of the First Vietnam War, which saw virtually every unit of the Legion serve, and that resulted in almost 12,000 deaths of Legion troops. This book is printed on high quality paper, with excellent color photographs of the subject matter, along with many excellent black white, with some color also, photos of Foreign Legion troops in the field, ceremonial events, and off duty. I have a number of books on the Legion, and have not previously seen 90% of the photos. Included are short 2-3 page histories of the various Legion regiments, and smaller unit's service in Indochina. The book is 80% or so photos and illustrations, so limited comprehension in French is all that's required to enjoy it.
