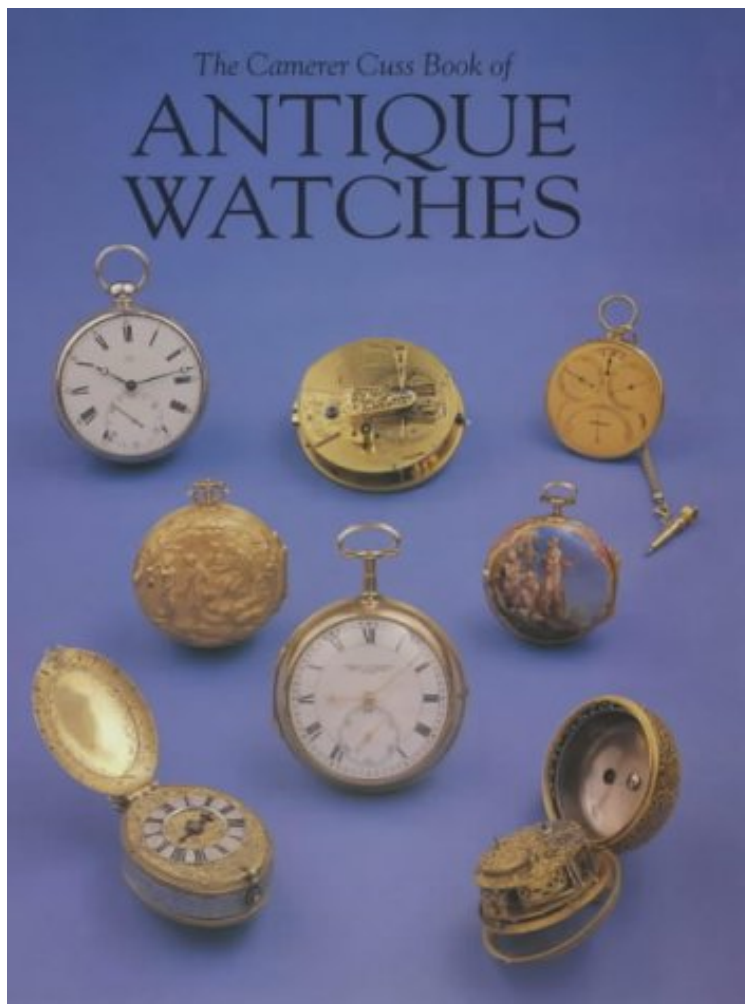

The section of illustrations is called the chronology of the watch and proceeds logically from earliest to latest with the inclusion of one wristwatch as an epitaph for the pocket and fob variety. There are examples of superb engineering with a glossary at the back to explain the more esoteric terms for the tyro. And there are examples of watches that could be considered pieces of jewellery that incidentally tell the time.

Musical, repeating, grande complication, mystery and even a wooden cased wooden movement dismissed rather curtly, all types are illustrated here from the grandest makers to the occasional anonymous watch that might have a design feature or case that is atypical. From a trusted publisher and an impeccable source, the person interested in the
