Author Patsy Clevenger, who describes the smiles of the MM characters as "absolutely infectious," first provides readers with a concise review of the candy's history, including a timeline of MM colors featured from 1940 through the 1990s. This comprehensive and enjoyable guide then leads the reader on a tasty tour of MM collectibles, complete with values for the hundreds of items shown, which range from kitchen towels to tins, toppers, posters, and jewelry.

Additional sections on advertising items and MM packaging round out the book.
