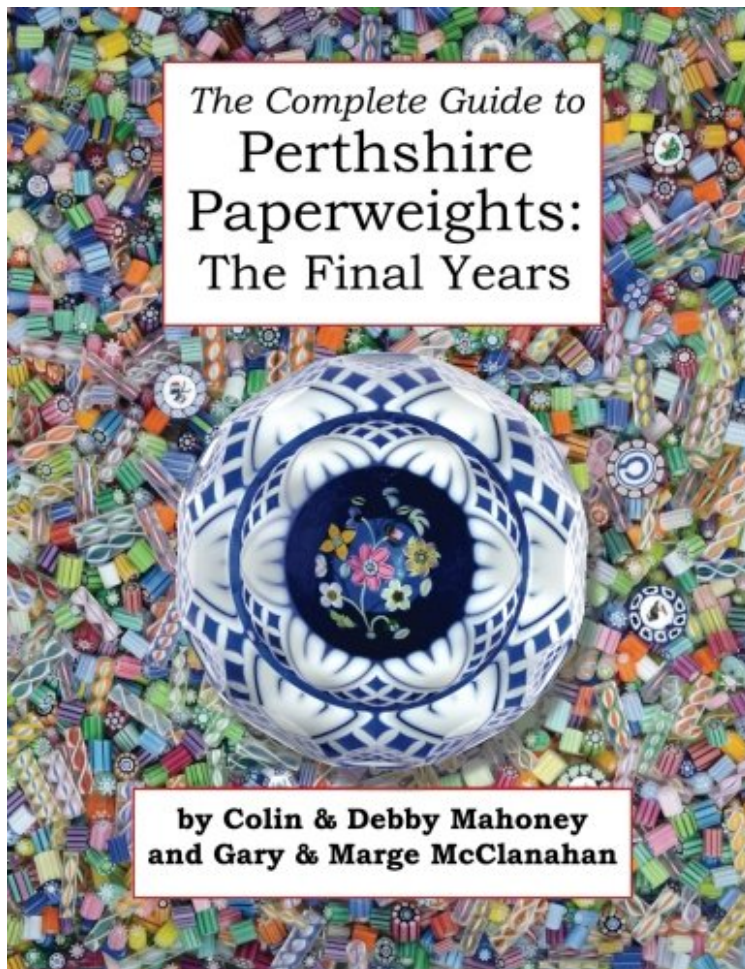

paper on which it's printed. The first volume was printed entirely on glossy paper, which makes the images really brilliant. The second volume is printed on regular book paper, however, and as a result the images aren't nearly as vibrant. Likely this is because Larry Selman decided to retire, taking Paperweight Press with him, and Colin had to self publish the second volume.
